**Notes:** A notable recording of the sound of the guácharo birds gurgling and scolding vehemently in this Peruvian cave. We also seem to be hearing water running in the background.

This cave is located in the "heart of Peruvian Amazonia" in the Massif de la Bella Dumiente within the Parc Nacional de Tingo María, 6 km southwest of Tingo María. The cave shelters countless swallows, bats, parrots, and "owls." "Leshuzas" translates as owls and it refers to the oilbirds or guácharo birds.



The guácharo navigate in the cave by echolocation clicks and build their nests in the cave walls. They feed on fruits of peach palm, palm trees, and other plants.
