**Notes:** The bat sounds here are chitters and hard fluttering sounds that increase in rapidity. More than likely these are bat sounds generated electronically.

The back pic cover of the LP shows 5 small stylized bats flying in a night sky. The three witches gathered around the steaming iron kettle recall the cavern scene in Shakespeare's *Macbeth* (Act IV, Scene I) where three witches hover over their boiling caldron and one says – "In the caldron boil and bake/ Eye of newt and toe of frog/ Wool of bat and tongue of dog ..." This cover is not included in the Bat Picture Covers section because the bats are too insignificant in this illustration.

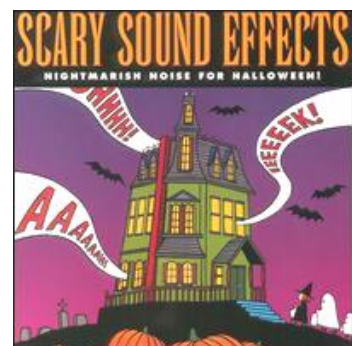

**Notes:** The 30-second audio clips: Track 31 – the fake sounds of a bat colony increase in volume then fade then surge back; Track 32 – warping electric whirrs, weird voice making weird wails, sequences of whirling electronic stuff; Track 33 – whirling electronic waves heard in the distance echo about, high-pitched wails.

**Notes:** Reputed field recording of bat sounds: chittering and hard throbbing sounds. These [bat sounds](#) seem authentic, but they could have been generated electronically.

The picture cover of the reissue CD shows 14 tiny stylized bats flying in a twilight sky around a house. This cover is not included in the Bat Picture Covers section because the bats are too insignificant in this illustration.

The K-Tel reissue CD has an extra bat-sound track 43 entitled, “Beeper Bats.” Nothing is known about this track.

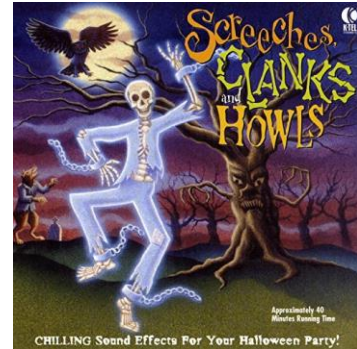

**Notes:** A 30-second [audio clip](#) started with a sharp sudden gong, sharp cries, then another sharp gong, wails, quack & quirk sounds, followed by bird-like chittering. Another minute and a half [sample](#) had the gong and screeches alternating, then whines and quirk sounds, chittering, gong, continuous chittering increasing in intensity.
