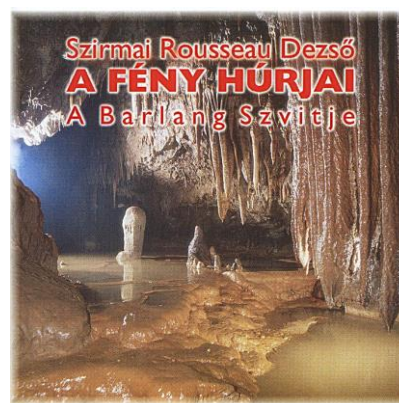

**Notes:** The title of this CD translates as “Strings of Light.”

The cover photo show of nice formation room probably in one of the caves within the Aggtelek Karst country, but it is not known which cave. Several drapery stalactites hang on the right. A few small stalagmites are in the muddy water of a rimstone dam and one large stalagmite (?) is in the foreground on the left.



The back cover of the CD has a very nice robust stalagmite with secondary calcite deposition, which is shown cut out against a red background with a sun-like disc shining. It is not known where this cave formation is located.

The CD itself has the logo of the Aggteleki Nemzeti Park showing the cave dwelling salamander (*Salamandra salamandra*).

The back cover has the five musicians playing their instruments (with their amps & speakers) in the room called "Märchenland" (Tündérország = Fairyland). Some grungy stalagmites are in the middle foreground of this small room
