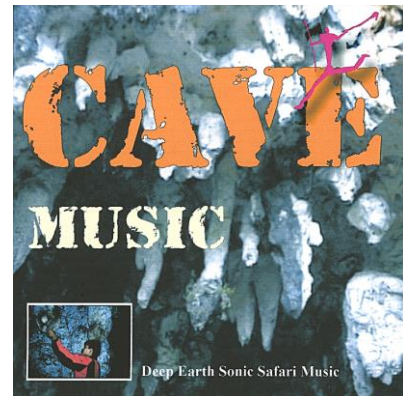

**Notes:** The cover is a blue-tinted view looking upward at some sunlit dried white stalactites in this cave entrance. A small vignette in the lower left shows one of the percussionists striking a stalactite with a padded mallet. The same photo of the white stalactites tinted blue is used on the CD itself and (in black & white) on the reverse side of the liner notes.



On the backside of the CD a slightly different wider blue-tinted shot shows the cave floor and the passage beneath the same sunlit stalactites. In the lower right corner of the backside of the CD is another small vignette showing the hand drummer and two of the women singers inside the cave. A red stick figure running with a spear in his right hand (probably representing a prehistoric painting or engraving from some local

site) is included on the front and back covers and also on the CD itself.
