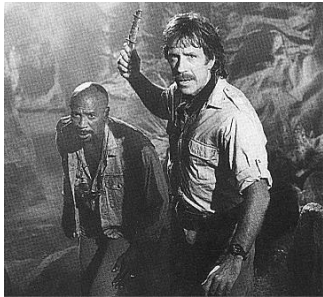

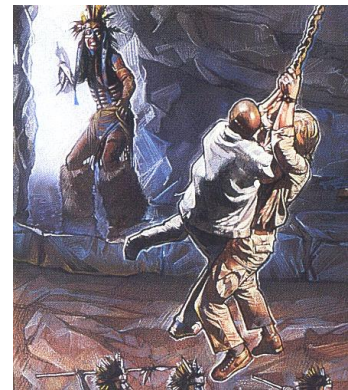

**Notes:** On the front cover is a montage of photos and painted scenes probably from the film poster. In the upper left an Indian with headdress,



threatening with a knife, approaches down a cave passage (studio set) while the two heroes of the film, Chuck Norris and Lou Gossett, cling together at the end of a single rope and swing toward him (shown here).



On the back cover are five movie stills, two of which show scenes in the cave – one has Norris holding a pistol & Gossett holding a decorated knife both crouching to discuss and the other (shown here) has Norris getting ready to throw the knife while Gossett hangs by his side. Judging by these photos the cave sets appear to have been constructed on flat studio floors in the clumsiest possible way out of cardboard and papier-mâché.

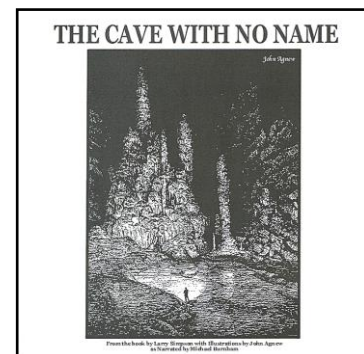

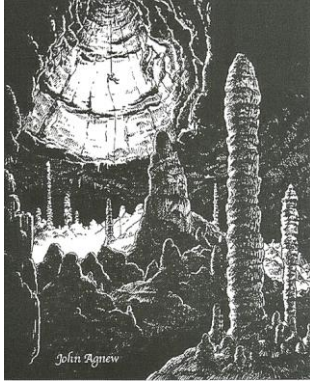

**Notes:** The CD cover uses an illustration of a huge cave chamber with tall stalagmites. A small caver standing on rimstone dams in the middle ground provides scale. This sketch appeared on page 32 of the book to illustrate the episode “Yonder Beyond.” Inside the 4-page liner notes are two more John Agnew illustrations: one of the huge entrance room of the Cave with No Name with its tall stalagmites and a caver rappelling down the shaft (page 3 – “Descent into Fantasia” – shown here) and the other of a bearded, haggard caver lighting his way with a glowing spar as he staggers through a vadose passage (page 42 – “Emergence”).

The two CDs of the 2004 edition carry simplified illustrations: Disc 1 has a variant on the caver rappelling down a rope and Disc 2 has a caver free climbing a rock face.

**Notes:** Inside marine cave three pirates, two armed with swords, inspect a green treasure chest filled with piles of coins. From a rocky ledge above Captain Knaller and two of his crew, Quimbo, the ship’s cook and Pitter, the ship’s boy, prepare to attack them. Quimbo throws a rock and strikes the pirate on the left, the captain waves a club, and Pitter gets ready to throw a rock.

The first cover shows the inside of a cave where one man holds a gun on two others that are gathered around stolen moneybags. Jimmy (in blue shirt) and the Native American Little Bear (in foreground) look on and smile.

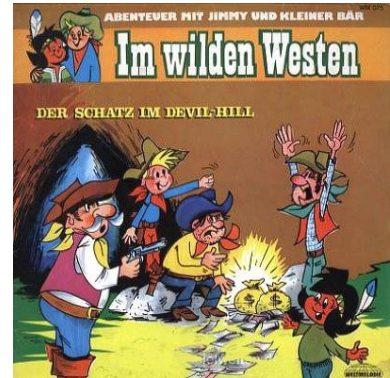
The second reissue cover also shows the inside of a cave where Jimmy (in blue shirt) and the Native American Little Bear (on right) open a treasure chest and find it filled with gold coins.

Outside the entrance two men on horseback argue. One points to a map, which the other holds out.

The first cover shows three young children in a cave gathered around a glowing red ball that floats in the air. The girl holds a candle and one of the boys holds a mineral hammer. A metal chest filled with what looks like packets is on the right. Various objects and a flashlight are strewn on the floor.

The second reissue cover shows three teenagers gathered around the glowing red ball in a cave passage close to the entrance. The boy with glasses on the right, probably the Professor, points to the ball.

**Notes:** A German Hörspiele (audio play), an adaptation of Enid Blyton's "Secret Seven Win Through." Two different covers were used on different editions of this disc in 1979.

The first cover shows the six children and their dog in the cave.



Three of the kids with their dog are on the floor of a large room looking up at another boy who is on an upper ledge. Two other children climb the cave wall on the right. The boy up on the ledge is holding up what looks to be a sack.

The second edition cover shows four children in the entrance of the cave. In the field outside the cave is a large scarecrow with the dog resting at its feet. One of the girls in the cave entrance points to a man, with a shovel under his arm, who is passing by in the distance. There is a candle lantern hanging from the entrance roof and ivy growing along the dripline of the cave.

**Notes:** Two boys, Barney and Roger, lay on a ledge with their dog and a monkey, all looking out towards the entrance of a marine cave. A small rowboat with two men is being rowed out of the cave against a heavy sea. Blue stalactites hang from the ceiling.

**Notes:** A German Hörspiele (audio play), an adaptation of Enid Blyton's "The Secret Island." The four children are shown hiding in the cave with their cow and chickens. Outside the cave two men can be seen searching a trash-strewn beach.

There are several discrepancies between the events in the original story and what is shown in this illustration. The children were hiding with their animals in the inner room of the cave, not in view of the main entrance. The caves were up on a hill, nowhere near the beach. The children had the idea of strewing the beach with trash left by the day trippers so as to throw off any notion that they were living on the island.

However, this German radio play adaptation may have changed some things from the original story.

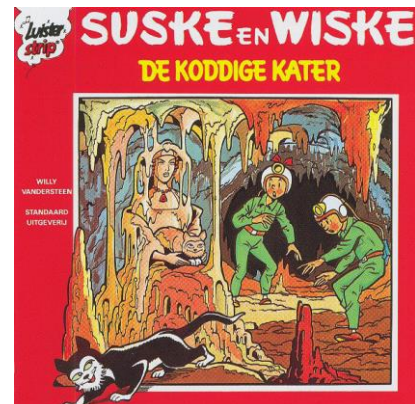

Bob and Bobette dressed in green coveralls with electric headlamps are surprised to see the black cat crossing in front of a massive stalagmitic formation, which is an old statue of a beautiful lady holding a cat on her lap, partially covered by calcite flowstone.

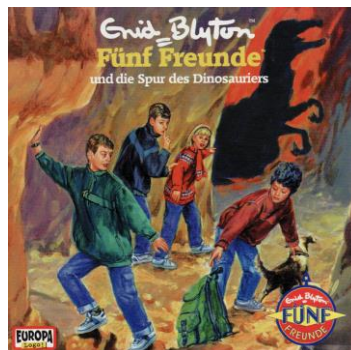
