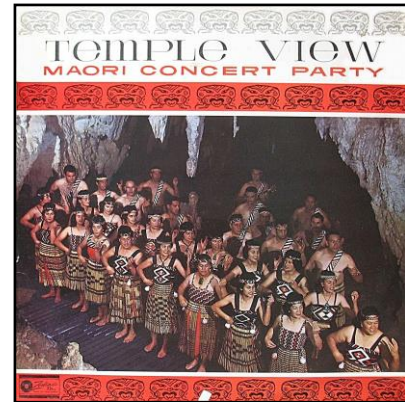

Notes: The cover has a backlit close up of two nice calcite draperies in the Waitomo Caves. The second page of the 6-page foldout insert has a composite orange-tinted photo of ten members of the adult choir matted over the same photo of the draperies that was used on the cover. This composite photo is printed again on the disc itself.

On the back page of the foldout is a photo of six members of the adult choir all dressed for a concert and holding candles, which would indicate that this photo was taken in the cave during a concert.
