Notes: A nicely lit color photo in this renowned Slovak show cave showing calcite draperies and stalactites on the walls around a cave pool, probably a rimstone pool. This scene in the cave has been identified with an old postcard, which shows this to be *Čarovné jazierko* (Charming Little Lake). A small stalagmite is in silhouette in the foreground. This photo very likely has been printed backwards.

Notes: A re-edition of the above disc. Another scene in this famous Slovak show cave. Here the bank of the cave river with massive calcite draperies and stalactites hanging down over flowstone cascades. This formation is called *Stromom života* (The Tree of Life).
