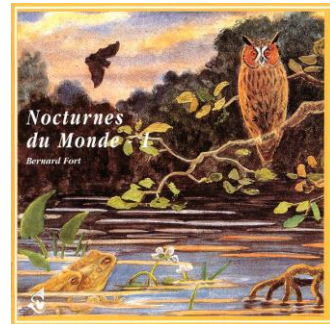

Notes: A bat (species unknown – possibly a long-eared bat) flies in a clear white sky. His shadow is seen at the bottom of the cover.



Similar bat cover art, although this time a stylized bat was used for the pic cover of two 45 singles of songs taken from this album and released at the same time: one shows the bat on the lower right on a blue field and the other has the bat flying in the other direction in the upper half on a white field. A similar stylized bat appeared again in 1983, flying left, on the gold label of a flexi disc release.

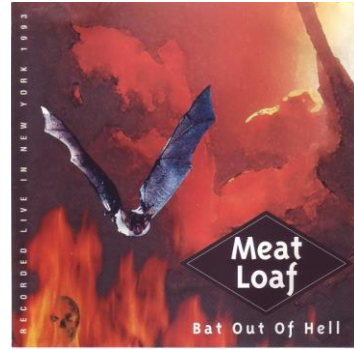

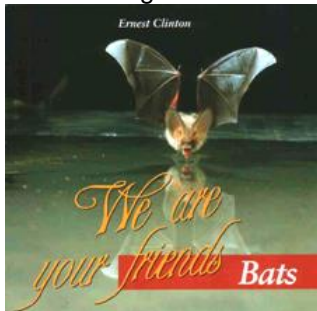

Notes: Several nice photos of bats are scattered about this CD package. On the cover is a long-eared bat swooping down to drink from a laboratory basin where his whole body is perfectly reflected on the calm surface. The back cover has another bat flying straight out of a cave with the EuroBats logo imprinted next to it (see here on right). Inside the 6-page liner note folder are four small round color vignettes of different bats, three of which are repeated in black and white next to the lyrics. One of these is the long-eared bat flying toward a flower and another appears to be a pipistrelle hanging up on a branch and yawning widely (see center vignette). The CD disc itself carries a nice color close-up of the long-eared bat flying right out of the black night of the music. And the inner tray card has a black and white reproduction of the cover photo.



No photo credits are given on this CD. The cover photo closely resembles [photos](#) of the Townsend's big-eared bat taken by Merlin B. Tuttle, founder of Bat Conservation International in Austin, Texas.

Notes: On the front cover two bats in flight and on the back cover six different bats in flight arranged symmetrically. Inside the gatefold cover on the left is a poor photo of a bat hanging (?) from the ceiling in the Kalkberghöhle, a show cave in gypsum near Bad Segeberg in northern Germany. On the right is a series of six different bats in flight arranged symmetrically. On the CD itself is another bat in flight where the bat's wings are both raised in an upward stroke.

Notes: The CD cover has a white silhouette of what appears to be a real bat flying in a black space. This same white silhouette bat appears three times within the liner notes folder. The back side of the liner note folder has a very nice grainy photo of a side-lit flying bat where the right wing is translucent.

Regarding the performing artist Morena Borattini and this title, “The Bat,”



her first album, we are told –

“L’album prende il nome da questo particolare animale che, come la sua autrice, non ci vede ma che riesce comunque a muoversi bene nel suo territorio, ed è scaltro e abile - un animale con cui Morena ha quindi assonanze, ed anche perchè tutto l’album è stato inciso sempre durante lunghe sedute in ore notturne.” (Anon. n.d.)

[The album takes its name from this particular animal, which like its author, cannot see us but is still able to move well in its territory, and is shrewd and clever – an animal which has similarities with Morena, and also because the entire album was recorded during long sessions at night.]

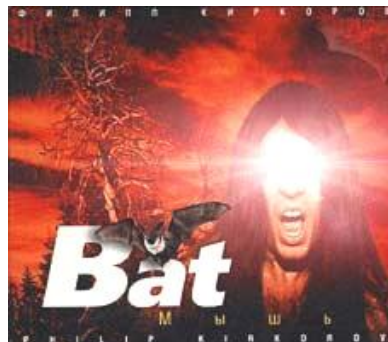
