
Notes: An elaborate collage featuring a hybrid bat robot with anatomically correct bat wings, a body consisting of diving rebreather gear, and an inverted T-shaped head combining human



upside-down "A" of the word "Bat." . Another small bat flies in the bottom right.



This is only the upper half of the foldout cover illustration of liner notes booklet. The bottom half shows a collage of the ribs of a human skeleton, an enchained human heart, a rocky mountainside with a cave entrance in the shape of a female sex organ, and a spider atop a green science fiction blob with long mauve wings. A stylized clasped hands motif completes the collage. Red drops of blood drip from the upper portion's ceiling and also from the fold of the liner notes.



The inside pages of the 12-page liner notes all have the anatomically correct bat wings joined by the stylized clasped hands motif.

The back cover has a profile of Jibi (?), the singer of the band using the re-breather mask and growing the anatomically correct bat wings. The inner tray card underneath the CD and DVD hinged plastic holder is the real bat again (a mad rousette) hanging from the cave ceiling where several drops of black blood hang down.
