Notes: The four members of this burlesque band barefoot and dressed in animal skins do their act on the rocks and sand in what appears to be the Forêt de Fontainebleau. From the left: one bends over and leans on his club; one sits on a rock and chews on a big chunk of meat; another raises his club and says “voilà” [there you are]; and the last, a cave girl, shrugs her shoulders and dances the frug.

Notes: The same four members of this burlesque band (see the preceding entry) barefoot and dressed in animal skins raise their left legs doing a line dance on a rock probably in the Forêt de Fontainebleau. However, here two have changed their wigs: the one that had long blond hair before has shorter red hair and the girl who had black hair before has the long blond hair wig.

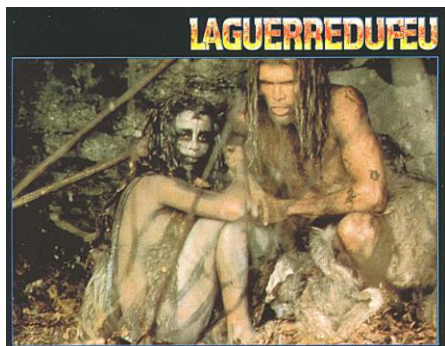

Notes: The front cover uses the movie poster motif of the profile of the painted face of a prehistoric man with bones in his nose and horns and lower jaws clustered on either side of his flowing red hair. Silhouetted in profile behind him are a mammoth head with curved tusks and a saber-tooth tiger. Superimposed on the left is a massed hoard of half-naked prehistoric people with flexed knees carrying spears as if ready to attack.

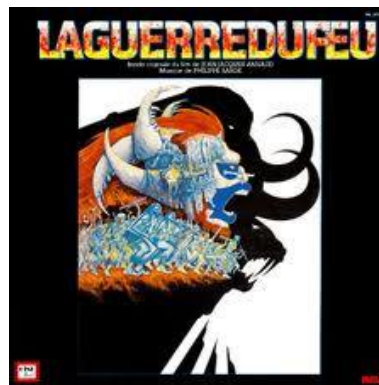


On the back cover is a block grouping of 10 stills from this film, including one of Noah and Ika crouched inside the shelter cave where they made love. Inside the gatefold cover are 6 more movie stills, including again the one just mentioned (shown here), plus a shot of the director, Jean-Jacques Annaud, with the main character, Noah (Everett McGill), in costume.

The 4-page insert sheet has four more movie stills including two of Noah, Amoukar, and Gaw up a tree trying to escape two lions.

A composite photo where in the foreground Alya stoops to pick up something and in the background six people sit around a fire in the cave.



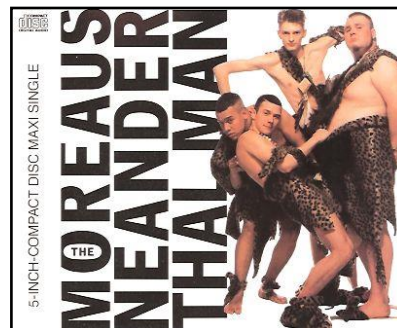

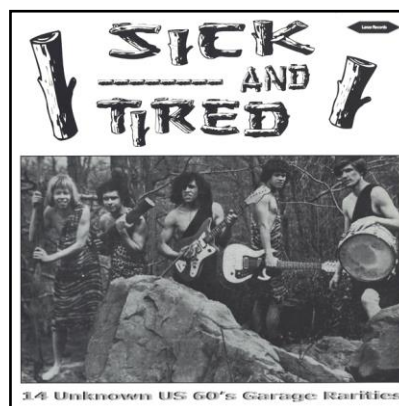

Notes: Shows five members of a 60s garage band dressed as cavemen (or something primitive) standing lined up with their instruments behind a large rock.

Notes: The musicians of this free jazz trio are dressed up as Neanderthal cavemen with long black wigs. They wear animal skins, leopard or other, and two of them have skin boots.

This album includes the spoken word piece, "Farewell to Neanderthal Man," which was found to not qualify as a cave or caveman spoken word recording (see under Not Cave Spoken Word – Jazz).

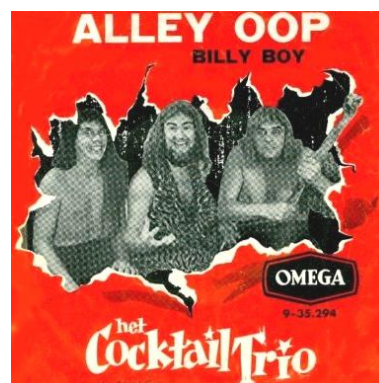

Notes: The members of the trio are dressed as prehistoric cavemen. The bearded one on the middle wears a leopard skin and the one on the right carries a sort of stone hammer stick.

This Dutch version of Dallas Frazier's song completely changes the lyrics and retains no flavor of prehistoric caveman.

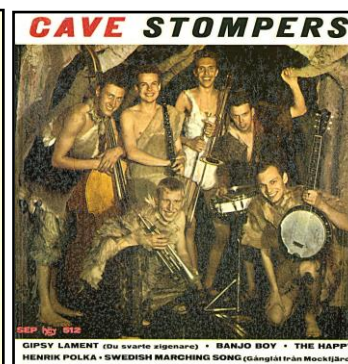
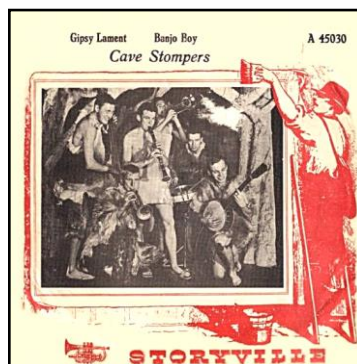

Notes: The six members of this Dixieland sextet are dressed up in skins and pelts to resemble cavemen as they pose with their instruments. They are surrounded on either side by what looks like strange trees and tree branches.

The single photo is black & white and the musicians play their instruments. Whereas the EP photo is in color and the band just poses with their instruments.
