The song writer, Ned Williams, signed all four songs that were released on Caveman 6621-22 and Caveman 8341-42.

Somewhat later, probably around 1963, the label name changed to "Caveman Supersonic Sound" (see entry below), an affiliate label. This reflects what happened at Cavern Records in Independence, Missouri, where the label name "Cavern" changed to "Cavern Sound."
