Notes: It seems altogether fitting and proper that in Missouri, the Cave State, there should be a record company with a label named, "Cavern." As for the label design you could hardly ask for anything better; two different designs, both showing a stylized cave entrance or cave passage.

FIRST LABEL DESIGN – A white label with the upper third portion a blue-gray grid where the label name, Cavern Records, is enclosed within a cave passage where small stalactites hang from the ceiling. It is not known if any releases were issued earlier than Cavern 2206.

SECOND LABEL DESIGN – Consists of a highly stylized motif showing a cave entrance arch with a few small stalactite forms (in darker greens on a light green label). On the singles this cave arch motif half surrounds the large spindle hole. Some of these labels have a thin black, arched band under the cave entrance indicating the interior of the cave, and others omit the black band. Together with this thin black arch are notched lines on either side at the base of the green stylized entrance arch.

Active during the late 1950s and early 60s, this single label was primarily oriented toward country music.

Located in Independence, Missouri, this record company released 45 singles on two different labels, Cave Records (see under Cave Records) and Cavern Records. Later, starting around the early 1970s, they released LPs on the Cavern Custom label (see below) and, to confuse matters, some of these LPs were also released on the Cavern label.

"Cavern Studios was an industrial cave used as a recording studio in the Kansas City suburb of Independence, MO that was active from the 1960s to 1980s. It was Kansas City's first 16-track recording studio. A slew of underground artists and ambitious country music enthusiasts recorded at Cavern, but a few famous musicians logged time in the studio, including such acts as Danny Cox, Brewer and Shipley, and James Brown." 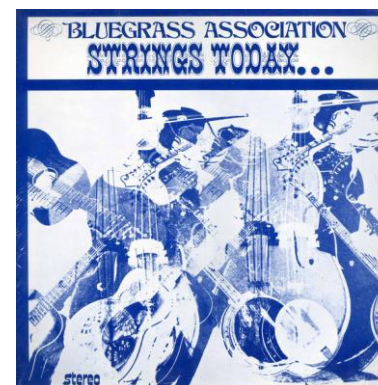
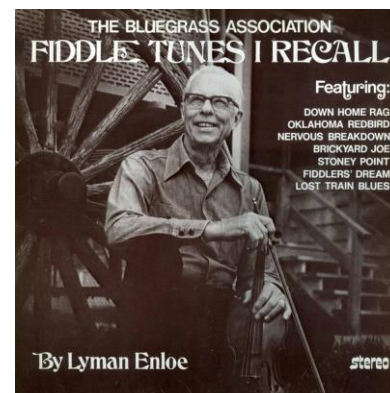

Notes: The Cavern Custom Recording Company had "multiple subterranean recordings studios." One of these was in an "industrial cave," probably an old mine or quarry tunnel. (Anon. 2016)

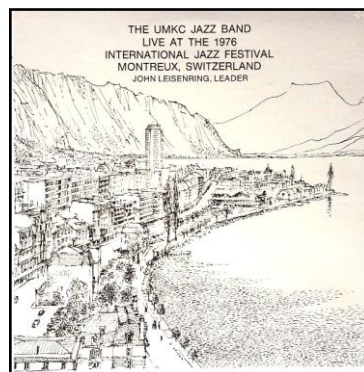
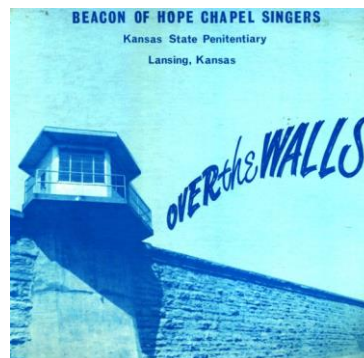
Located in Independence, Missouri, this record company released 45 singles on two different labels, Cave Records (see here under Cave Records) and Cavern Records (see above). Later, starting around the early 1970s, they released LPs on this Cavern Custom label and, to confuse matters, some LPs were also released on the Cavern label.

Independence touches Kansas City on the northeast and Truman Road runs east-west at the eastern end of town. In 1978, only seven caves were known in Jackson County where these cities are located (Weaver 1980)

Two known singles were released on the Cavern Custom label, but one carried no catalog number and both had very different label designs. The first was a green label with "Cavern Custom Recordings" printed above a black line and the second was a yellow label with "Cavern Custom" in bold capitols.

But Cavern Custom was primarily an LP label featuring country bands, jazz bands, and high school bands, all from Midwestern United States. Some of the information was found on vinyl record sales lists on Gemm.com Website (no longer online) where the label name was variously given as "Cavern" or "Cavern Custom." The "Cavern" LPs will be found in the above entry.
