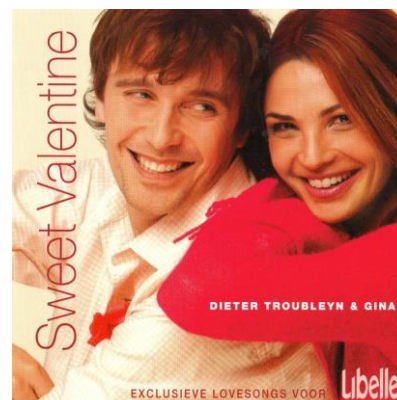
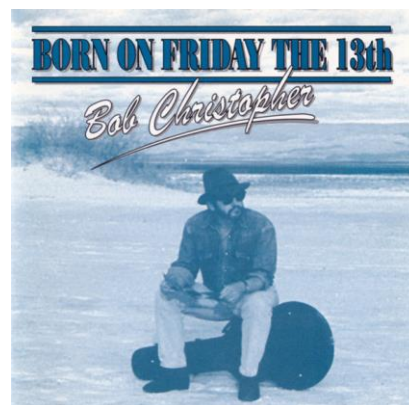

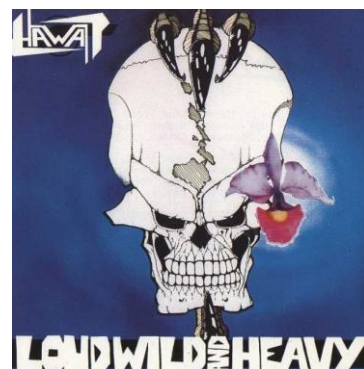

Notes: The Cavern Sound Recording Studio was installed at the famous Cavern cellar club in Feb. 1964 to provide demo-recording facilities for local groups. "Although Cavern Sound did have success for a brief period with an LP entitled Ee Aye Addio, a tribute album to the Liverpool FC [Football Club] FA Cup winning team, in general the venture did not prove to be a success and McFall [Andrew Ray, the club owner] acknowledged that he should have researched the idea and sought professional advice before going ahead with the project." (Thompson 1994)

The Ranchers only played once at the Cavern in 1965 on March 12, so this was not doubt the date of this recording or maybe it was recorded in the studio. (Thompson 1994) "Because the Cavern went into liquidation, most copies [of this 45] went to the official receiver, and it is the UK's most collectable British country single." (Rovi 2013)

The Ranchers single shows at the top of the label "C.S.L." (meaning Cavern Sound Limited) inside a red circle with a red "<" crossing the middle and at the bottom of the label "Recorded by Cavern Sound Ltd.". However, The Roadrunners EP shows only "Recorded by Cavern Sound Limited Liverpool" at the bottom of the label. The Liverpool F.C. LP makes no mention Cavern Sound on either label.

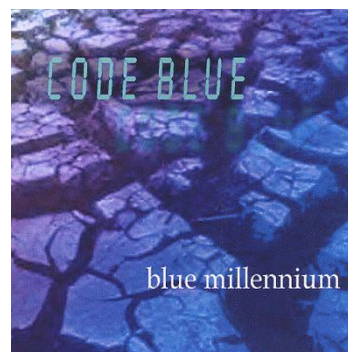
