aimed at releasing tough pumping techno with an edge." (Anon. 2016) Cave is the

pseudonym used by Inge Hofstad Kjeilen, a famous techno DJ from Oslo who started producing techno records in England in 2003. Even though his pseudo is cave-inspired it was decided to not include him in the section on cave-inspired group names, because he is recording by himself, not as a group, but as a disc jockey. (Not to be confused with the Chicago-based space rock group, Cave – see under Cave-Inspired Groups)

Spilo Records is his own label, which he started in 2005. The Pleistocene mammoth logo used by Spilo Records would seem to indicate some

connection with Paleolithic caveman and the similarity of the word "spilo" with the words "speleo" or "spelean" is also significant.

Several other releases were issued after 2005 right up to 2009 (see the links given here).
