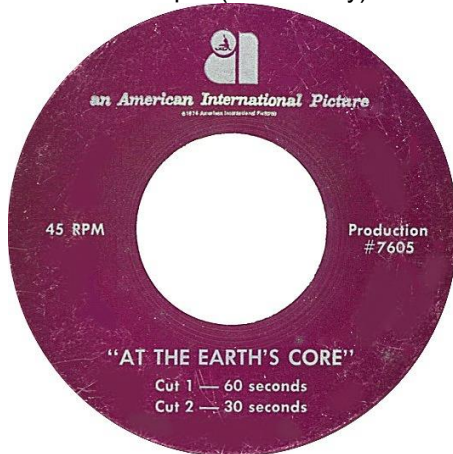

**Notes:** A radio announcement ad in the pure tradition of 50s and 60s horror films. This movie was one in a long series of “lost world” films that Hollywood churned out.

The spoken text starts – “Come on the most fantastic ad terrifying journey of your life. Four thousand miles into the center of the earth to a world within our world – at the earth’s core. (Crashing sound effects here) Now American International Pictures brings you at supersonic speed with Doug McClure and Peter Cushing to a world peopled by creatures beyond your wildest nightmares. (In a deeper voice) The Mezops whose fiery breath withers trees and plants. The vicious Mahars, dirt women who feed on human flesh. The giant [Dars?], lizard-like [...] with poison fangs. The cruel Sagoths, animal-like soldiers of Pellucidar ruled by the Princess Dian, whose seductive beauty could drive men mad. (Crash sound) Come on

the most incredible voyage ever dared by man – Edgar Rice Burroughs’ *At the Earth’s Core*. Rated PG (parental guidance suggested).

**Notes:** Another radio announcement ad for an earlier movie that was just another in a long series of "lost world" films.

Finally coming upon an island with an inhospitable coastline surrounded by icebergs — identified by von Schoenvorts as the legendary Caprona — they find an underground river and Bowen charts their path to dry land.



This radio spot mentions the scene where the submarine goes through the underwater cave passage to get to the inner lost world.

It was not possible to obtain the text of this spot. An audio sample of this radio spot was once available online, but has since disappeared. The structure of this announcement is the same as the above one, also by American International, and the same narrator's voice is heard, which sounds a lot like the announcer for the trailer at [YouTube](#).
