

HOW TO USE THIS PAGE

Since this Website has been created using html base pages containing only pdf documents, a special system of navigation within this site is required.

In order to fully take advantage of all the data concerning each music entry for each entry it is necessary to create tabs:

The first tab to be used as the reference page to read the data and notes about the chosen entry

The second tab to be used to go to the links for that entry to either hear the music or access sources

The third tab to follow the printed lyrics for that chosen song.

FOR BROWSER – GOOGLE CHROME

This site works best when using a Google Chrome browser

Choose the entry that you wish to consult then right click on it and select “Open link in new tab”

Repeat this process and right click on that same entry and select “Open link in new tab”

Then go down the blue column and select “Lyrics” and right click on it and select “Open link in new tab”

You now have 3 tabs at the top of your screen –

The first tab to be used as the reference page to read the data and notes about the chosen entry

The second tab to be used to go to the links for that entry to either hear the music or access sources –

You will be able to see the printed lyrics while you are listening to the song simply by going to the third tab

When finished hearing the music or consulting a source click on the return arrow to go back to the pdf page

The third tab is to follow the printed lyrics for that chosen song – Here you will need to notice the code number for the selected song indicated in blue next to the composer’s name and when you go to the lyrics page scroll down to that code number

If necessary you can even open a fourth tab for the abbreviations (this pdf document is at the bottom of the blue column)

FOR BROWSER – FIREFOX

This site works moderately well when you use a Firefox browser

Choose the entry that you wish to consult then right click on it and select "Open link in new tab"

(Each time that you create a new tab the selected pdf document will pop up and you will have to go back to the Jazz music base page and proceed to open another tab)

Repeat the process and right click on that same entry and select "Open link in new tab"

Then go down the blue column and select "Lyrics" and right click on it and select "Open link in new tab"

Once on the last chosen pdf page, right click and you will see within a black band the three pdf documents, that is the 2 copies of the chosen entry plus the lyrics page:

The first tab to be used as the reference page to read the data and notes about the chosen entry

The second tab to be used to go to the links for that entry to either hear the music or access sources

When finished hearing the music or consulting a source you will need to go back to the Jazz music base page and again click on the selected entry

The third tab is to see the printed lyrics for that chosen song – Here you will need to notice the code number for the selected song indicated in blue next to the composer's name and when you go to the lyrics page scroll down to that code number

You will not be able to see the printed lyrics while you are listening to the song

FOR BROWSER – INTERNET EXPLORER

Things get very complicated for Internet Explorer because it uses the Windows 8 system.

Best said, this site really does not work properly when you use Internet Explorer.

Choose the entry that you wish to consult then right click on it and select "Open link in new tab"

Then go down the blue column and select "Lyrics" and right click on it and select "Open link in new tab"

Now go back and click on the entry you have selected and open it

Once the chosen pdf page has been opened, right click and you will see within a black band the chosen pdf document plus the lyrics pdf document

Then all you have to do is click on the desired pdf document

When consulting a pdf document for a entry, click on links for a chosen entry to either hear the music or access sources

Once you are finished and go to close the link you will automatically return to the Jazz music base page and be obliged to repeat the entire process outlined above

The second tab is to see the printed lyrics for that chosen song – Here you will need to notice the code number for the selected song indicated in blue next to the composer's name and when you go to the lyrics page scroll down to that code number

You will not be able to see the printed lyrics while you are listening to the song
